If you require a single seat, simply divide the total amount you choose in half. If you require more than one pair of seats, please contact us for a customized package. Patrons receive first priority for seating based on the amount donated. All Patrons are acknowledged in each concert printed program in graduated type size by level. Receives 4 blue seats (\$1,100 value)



As the symphony is still recovering from the economic effects of the pandemic, our Patrons came through again in support of our mission. Patron contributions covered 61% of our operating expenses in 2022, an increase of 5% from pre-pandemic levels.
