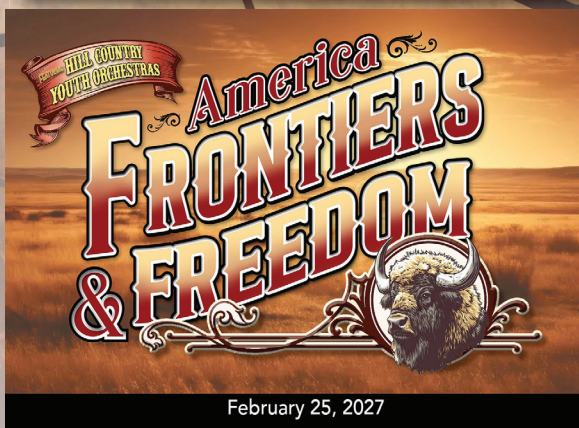

Most of you know the drill. Please review the material in your packet. We like to keep the process as simple as we can. **If you wish to sign up for the same seats, the process will be as easy as always, whether you pay by check or with credit card. The amount due for your ticket(s) is indicated on your form.** As in the past, our Patrons will be assigned seats first, then Subscribers will be assigned seats after Patrons' orders are fulfilled. We are again expediting the process so that we conclude Patron signup/renewal by June 11 and Subscriber signup/renewal by June 25. This will allow us to send out your season tickets by mid-August. Individual tickets will go on sale in late August.

We are not slacking on our commitment to provide exciting symphonic music as we kick off our second twenty-five years. Some of the highlights include Brahms, Webber's "Phantom of the Opera," holiday music both inspiring and humorous, the music of good guys and bad guys at the Pops concert, American classics, solo selections from our own musicians, and a season finale with Nancy Zhou back to do her magic with Tchaikovsky's D Major Violin Concerto.

Patron Levels and Seating

Patrons are generous donors who, for their donation within the following categories, receive priority seating for two in the color-coded categories listed below (please see seating chart on the back of this brochure). Prices include a pair of tickets. If you want only one seat, just reduce the prices listed by 50%. All Patrons are acknowledged in the printed program for each concert.

Friend	\$350 - \$474	Includes 2 red seats (\$310 value)
Musician	\$475 - \$824	Includes 2 orange seats (\$410 value)
Concert Master	\$825 - \$1,449	Includes 2 yellow seats (\$460 value)
Soloist	\$1,450 - \$2,499	Includes 2 green seats (\$560 value)
Maestro	\$2,500- \$4,999	Includes 2 blue seats (\$610 value)
Dress Circle	\$5,000 - \$9,999	Includes up to 4 blue seats (up to \$1,220 value)
Performance Sponsor	\$10,000+	Includes up to 8 seats at any level (up to \$2,440 value)

Payments received from Patrons will be given priority based on the amount of their gift and on a first-come, first served basis through Thursday, June 11, 2026. Subscribers' seating assignments will be made after that date when all Patrons' seats have been assigned.

Season Seating Prices for Subscribers

Subscribers are season ticket holders whose seat locations are assigned after Patrons' enrollment is complete in the best remaining locations within the price levels shown below. If you wish to purchase season seats as a Subscriber, please circle the seat level you would like to purchase (please see seating chart shown on the back this brochure). Prices include a pair of tickets; if you want only one seat, just reduce the prices listed by 50%.

Thursday, April 30, 2026	Season enrollment opens for Patrons and Subscribers
Thursday, June 11, 2026	Deadline for Patrons to renew; Patron's seats are assigned
Thursday, June 25, 2026	Deadline for Subscribers to renew; Subscribers' seats are assigned
Monday, August 17, 2026	Patrons' and Subscribers' tickets are mailed this week
Monday, August 24, 2026	Any remaining tickets go on sale for individual performances

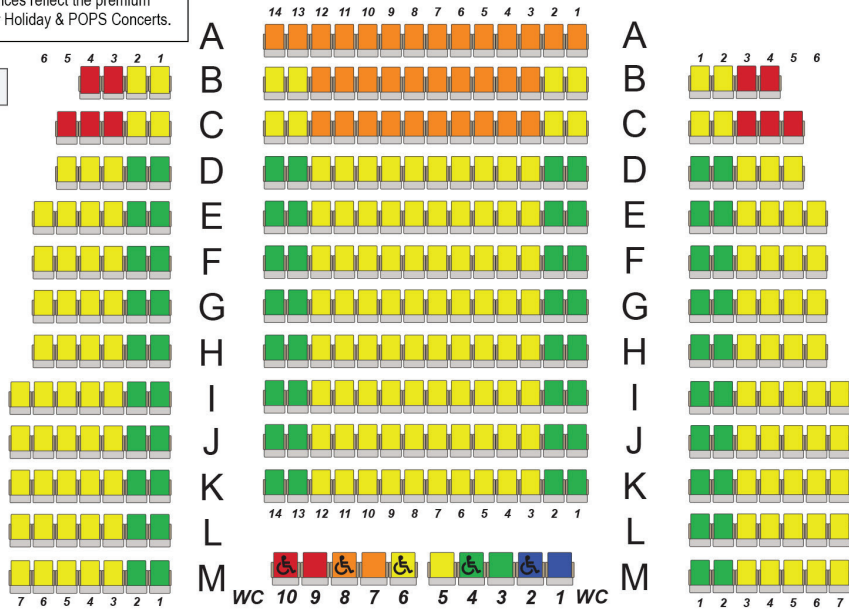
